Building bridges of peace in South Korea!

We're excited to know that your congregation uses the Mennonite Mission Network mission bank tools. These materials will help you teach your children and congregation about mission in this South Korean community.

The materials can be used a number of ways:

- Children's Sunday school class mission project
 - o Tell the stories as part of the opening time, and then post them to a bulletin board.
 - o Place the map low enough on a bulletin board for children to point out the country.
 - o Order a children's card for each child to take home with them as a reminder to pray.
- A congregational mission and stewardship project
 - o Use the children's stories during worship.
 - o Encourage children to act out a story in the worship service.
 - o Host a carry-in meal, with the suggested recipes, to encourage the congregation to help with the children's fundraising efforts for mission in South Korea.

These materials are easy to adapt to fit your congregation's needs. This packet includes two copies of the children's card for bulletin board purposes.
